The Quays Marina and Q Service seeks to ensure that it can contribute to a high quality of life by protecting and enhancing the environment and by supporting the concept of environmentally sustainable practices. The Quays Marina and Q Service provides valuable support to recreational boating and commercial vessels by repairing and maintaining vessels, providing fuel and other services to the boating community. We pride ourselves in fostering a positive relationship with local residents and other industry providers.

We will ensure that our environmental priorities are included in decisions regarding our services and are committed to:

- Conducting our operations in compliance with all relevant environmental regulations, licences and legislation;
- Eliminating the unnecessary use of energy by introducing best industry site-specific practices where possible and ensuring any current practices to reduce usage are applied;
- Avoiding waste and encouraging the conservation, reuse and appropriate recycling of resources;
- Promoting the use of vessel pump-out facility for management of sewage and grey water and improved quality of our waterways;
- Reducing air, land and water pollution in a process of continuous improvement through daily and weekly monitoring by boatyard operators and the Marina Manager;
- Applying principles of risk management in order to pre-empt, rather than respond to, environmental problems and always apply the 'precautionary principle';
- Promoting understanding and participation in environmental issues through education, information provision and consultation with employees, contractors, customers, local residents and the community;
- Reviewing all our environmental practices annually and seeking to continually improve our environmental performance; and
- Working with industry and other stakeholders at a local level to encourage good environmental practices.

We expect all our Marina customers, contractors and tenants to follow our environmental standards to help keep our waterways clean.
